A few weeks ago, to the joy of Jews around the world, Gilad Shalit, the twenty-five year old Israeli soldier who had been captured by the Palestinians, was finally returned home.

Although the looming repercussions of the prisoner exchange by the Israeli government have yet to pan out, we should instead concentrate on the bliss of momentary solace for Gilad, his family, the state of Israel, and this great feat that encompasses the global Jewish community.

For five years that Gilad was held, not as a prisoner of war but rather as a captive, the Israeli government has vigilantly tried to obtain his release.
